
### **Welcome Back!**

## Personal Mobile Devices and Social Media -Definitions

- Personal mobile devices include any electronic device that can be used to communicate with or access the internet. It includes cellphones, tablets, laptops/Chromebooks, smartwatches, or other devices or gaming systems.
- Social media refers to websites and applications that enable users to create and share content or to participate in social networking (for example, make comments or chat).



## Procedure Regarding Personal Mobile Devices at Rochester School

Aspen View Public Schools is developing a division Administrative Procedure regarding Personal Mobile Devices and Social Media. In the meantime, following the Ministerial Order from June 17, 2024, Rochester school will use the following Procedure for the start of the 2024-2025 school year.

- 1. Personal mobile devices are valuable. The owner or user is responsible for their security or storage. Rochester School and Aspen View Public Schools assume no responsibility for the safety, security, loss, repair, or replacement of these devices.
- 2. Students are not permitted to use personal mobile devices during instructional time.
  - a. Exemptions to this will be determined by the principal or designate and will be for health or medical reasons, or to support special learning needs.
- 3. Students in kindergarten to grade 6 will not be given any time during the school day to spend on personal mobile devices.
- 4. Students in grades 7 to 9 **may** be provided limited designated time to use personal mobile devices as determined by their teacher, but not during lunch or recess.
- 5. During the school day, personal mobile devices must be kept silent (including no vibration) or powered off and stored in their locker or backpack, but not within reach.
- 6. Students may not use breaks between classes or during classes to use a device, this is still instructional time.

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### **Social Media**

Aspen View Public Schools' publicly accessible wireless network will be configured to block access to social media websites and applications as defined by the division's web filter system.



## Procedure Regarding Personal Mobile Devices at Rochester School

Failure to comply with the procedure as outlined will result in the following:

- 1. First offence—The student's personal mobile device will be confiscated and stored securely in the school office. The teacher will advise the student's parent/guardian by phone or email. The student can retrieve the device at the end of the day (just before buses leave). A note will be entered into the system by the teacher or administrator by the end of the day. Note: The student will not be reminded to pick up their device before leaving school.
- 2. Second offence—The student's personal mobile device will be confiscated and stored securely in the school office. The teacher will advise the student's parent/guardian by phone or email. The student's parent/guardian can retrieve the device as early as the end of the school day. A note will be entered into the system by the teacher or administrator by the end of the day.
- 3. Third and subsequent offence—The consequences will follow #2 above, plus progressive discipline as laid out in Administrative Procedure 355: Student Code of Conduct and Discipline.

## Family Breakfast

Immediate families are invited to Rochester School for a Family Breakfast on October 18, 2024. Breakfast will be served from 8:30 to 9:30 AM. Following breakfast, the school will provide some highlights from the first few weeks of school and give time to answer questions or concerns parents/guardians may have regarding transition or celebration. Prior to the event, we will send home a form where you can indicate whether you can attend and how many we will expect.
